In August 2019, he served on a trial team that won a complete defense verdict on behalf of a New York City hospital in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of New York against four deaf patients alleging discrimination under federal, state, and city law. Mr. Sittenreich also appears on behalf of hospitals at hearings under the New York Mental Hygiene Law.

Prior to joining the firm, Mr. Sittenreich was an attorney in the Health Care Division of the Federal Trade Commission's Bureau of Competition, where he worked on antitrust investigations in the pharmaceutical industry. He began his career as a law clerk to the Honorable Carolyn E. Demarest, Presiding Justice of the Kings County Commercial Division of the New York State Supreme Court.

Mr. Sittenreich received his B.A., *summa cum laude*, in 2007 from Tufts University, where he was elected to Phi Beta Kappa, and his J.D., *magna cum laude*, in 2011 from Fordham University School of Law, where he was an Associate Editor of the Fordham Law Review and elected to Order of the Coif.
