



New State Department of Health Regulations Require a Hospital to Develop Policies and Procedures if it Allows Patients to Bring In and Self-Administer Medical Marijuana

New York State Department of Health (DOH) regulations took effect on May 17, 2017 that require hospitals to develop policies and procedures if they allow patients to bring in and self-administer medical marijuana.

The DOH regulations require that the hospital's policies and procedures address security of the medical marijuana product, verification that the patient is capable of self-administering the medical marijuana, and record-keeping requirements, to name a few.

Hospitals should review the regulations and ensure that its policies and procedures are sufficient to meet the new requirements.
